ORDER


Acting under the authority of Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the state of emergency declared statewide by Governor Jeff Landry in advance of inclement winter weather in Executive Order Number JML 26-006 on January 22, 2026, and the continuing effects of the winter storm and power outages in several parts of the State,

It is HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

This Court's Order of January 25, 2026, extending filing deadlines statewide is hereby extended through Friday, January 30, 2026. All filings statewide due on Monday, January 26 through Friday, January 30, 2026, shall be deemed timely filed if filed on or before Monday, February 2, 2026.
