WICKER, J., DENIED WITH REASONS

Relator, State of Louisiana through the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and Office of State Police, et al., seeks reconsideration of this Court’s June 26, 2025 denial of its writ application number 25-C-131 C/W 25-C-138.

Uniform Rules-Courts of Appeal (“URCA”), Rule 2-18.7 provides as follows:

2-18.7. When Rehearing Will Be Considered

An application for rehearing will be considered in cases where the court has:

- (A) Granted a writ application on the merits;
- (B) Dismissed an appeal; or
- (C) Ruled on the merits of an appeal.

URCA Rule 4-9 provides that “Rules 2-18.1 through 2-18.7 apply to requests for rehearings related to writ applications.” Because Relator’s writ application was denied, Relator is not entitled to a rehearing. Therefore, Relator’s application for rehearing is denied.
